



Matsumoto city is based on an evacuation system assuming a planned scale of flood (above figure). However, depending on the rainfall situation, the city may shift to an evacuation system for an assumed maximum scale of flood (left figure), so please pay sufficient attention to the information on the hazard map.

Designated evacuation shelter
A facility that is established when residents who have evacuated due to the risk of a disaster stay as long as necessary until the risk of a disaster disappears, or when residents who have become unable to return to their homes due to a disaster stay temporarily

Designated emergency evacuation sites
A place of refuge to escape the danger of a disaster if it occurs or is likely to occur
